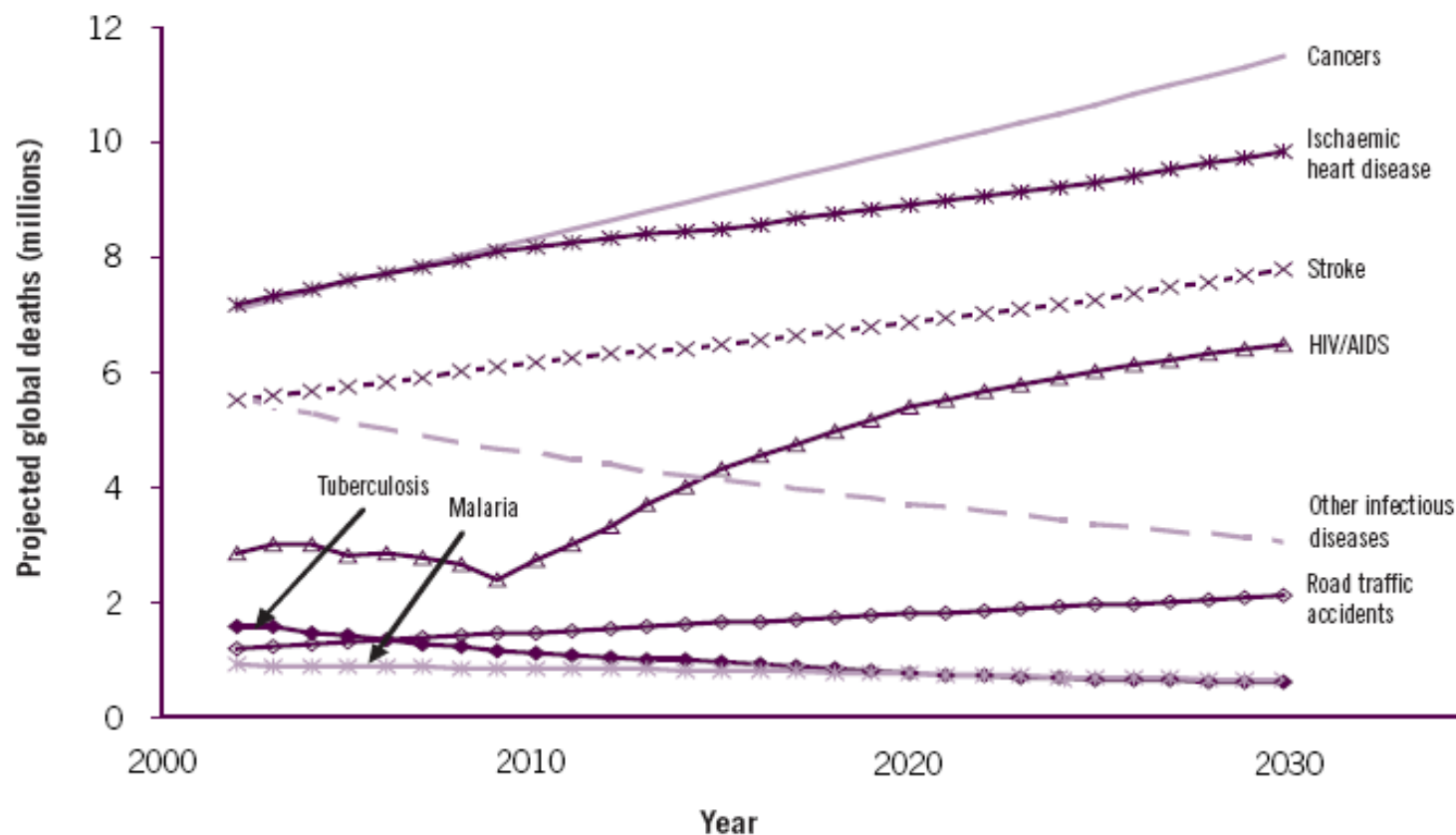
Cancer Incidence and Mortality Worldwide in 2008

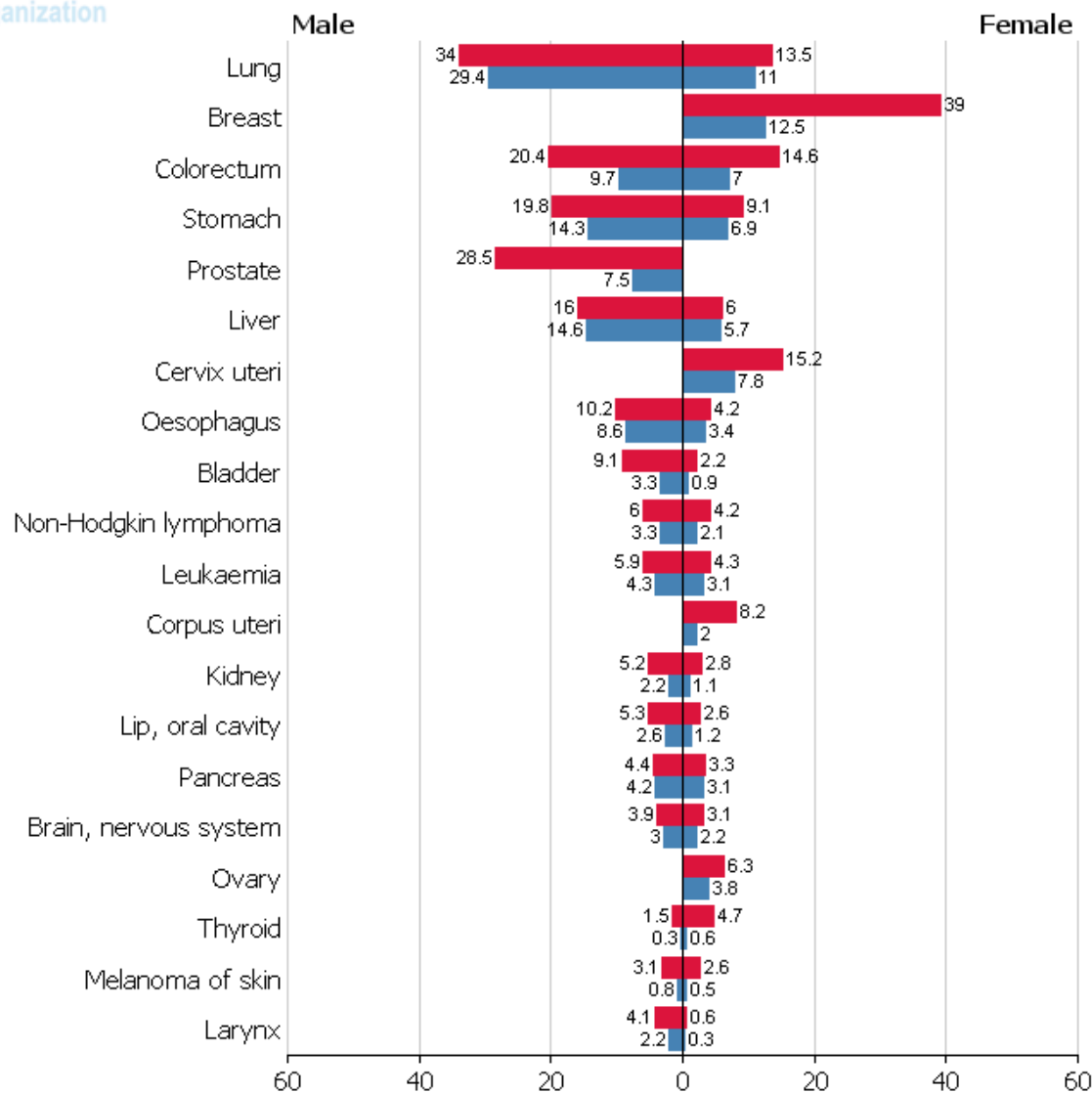
Proyección global del número de muertes según causa de muerte, 2002-2030

Projected global deaths for selected causes of death, 2002–2030¹⁵



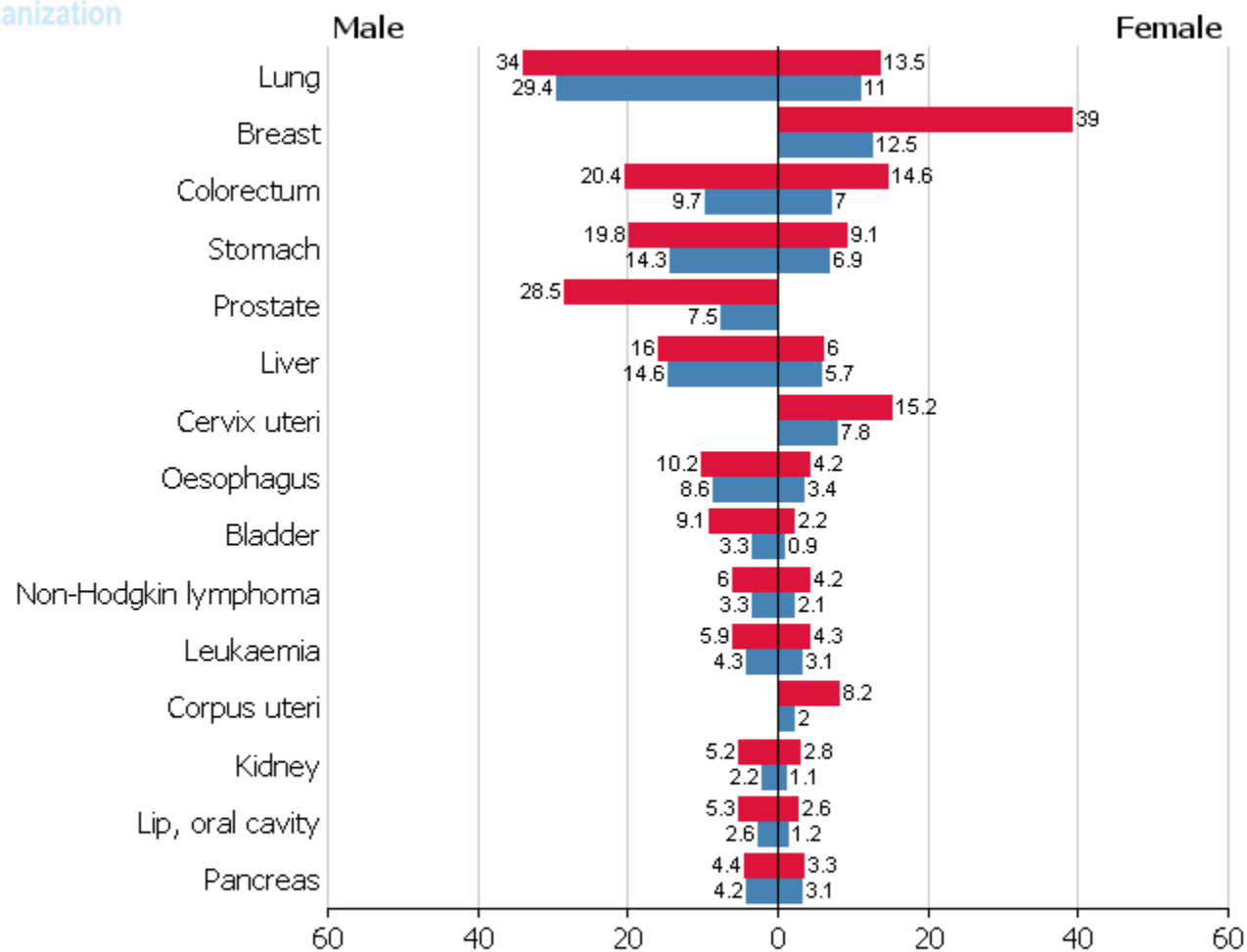

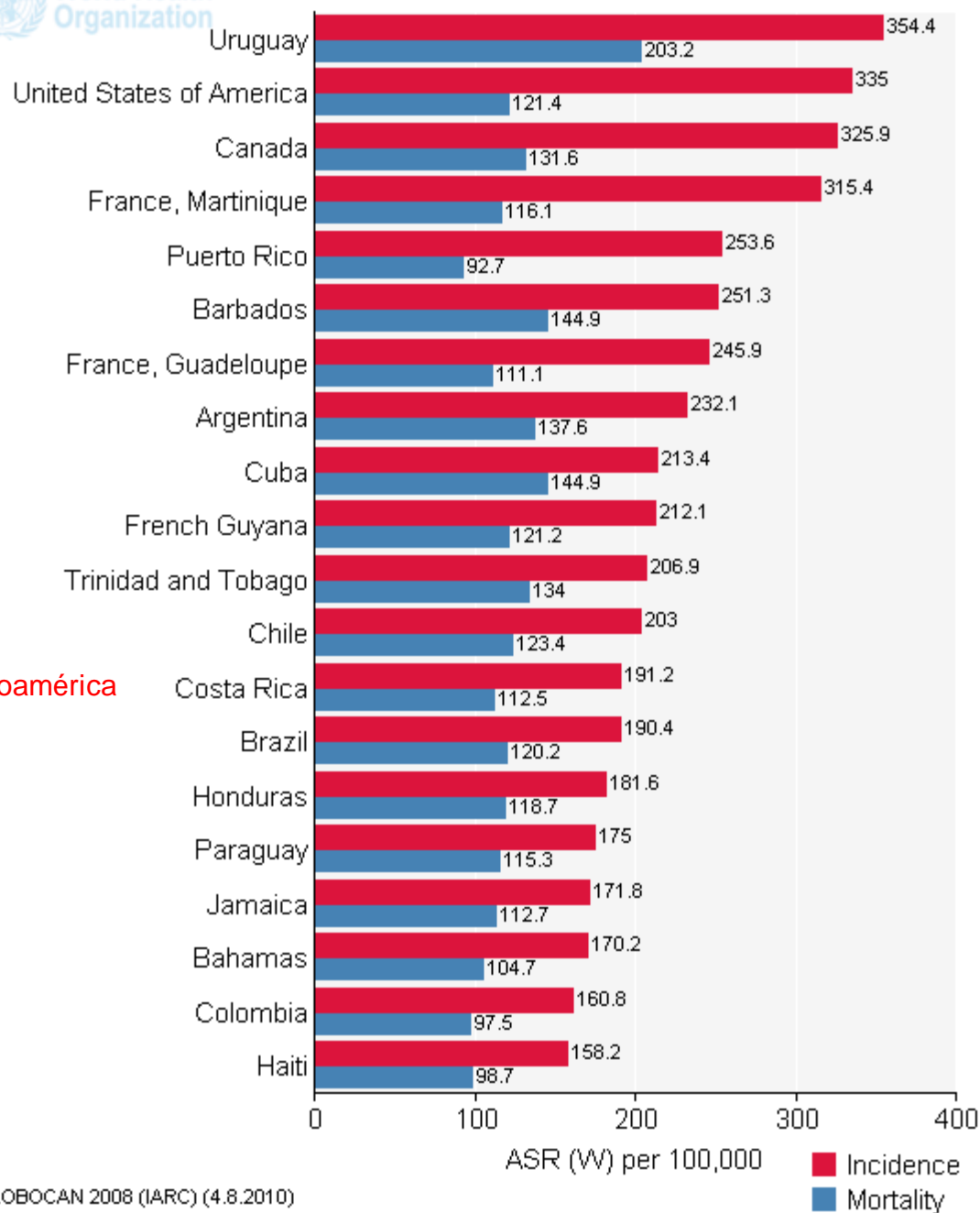

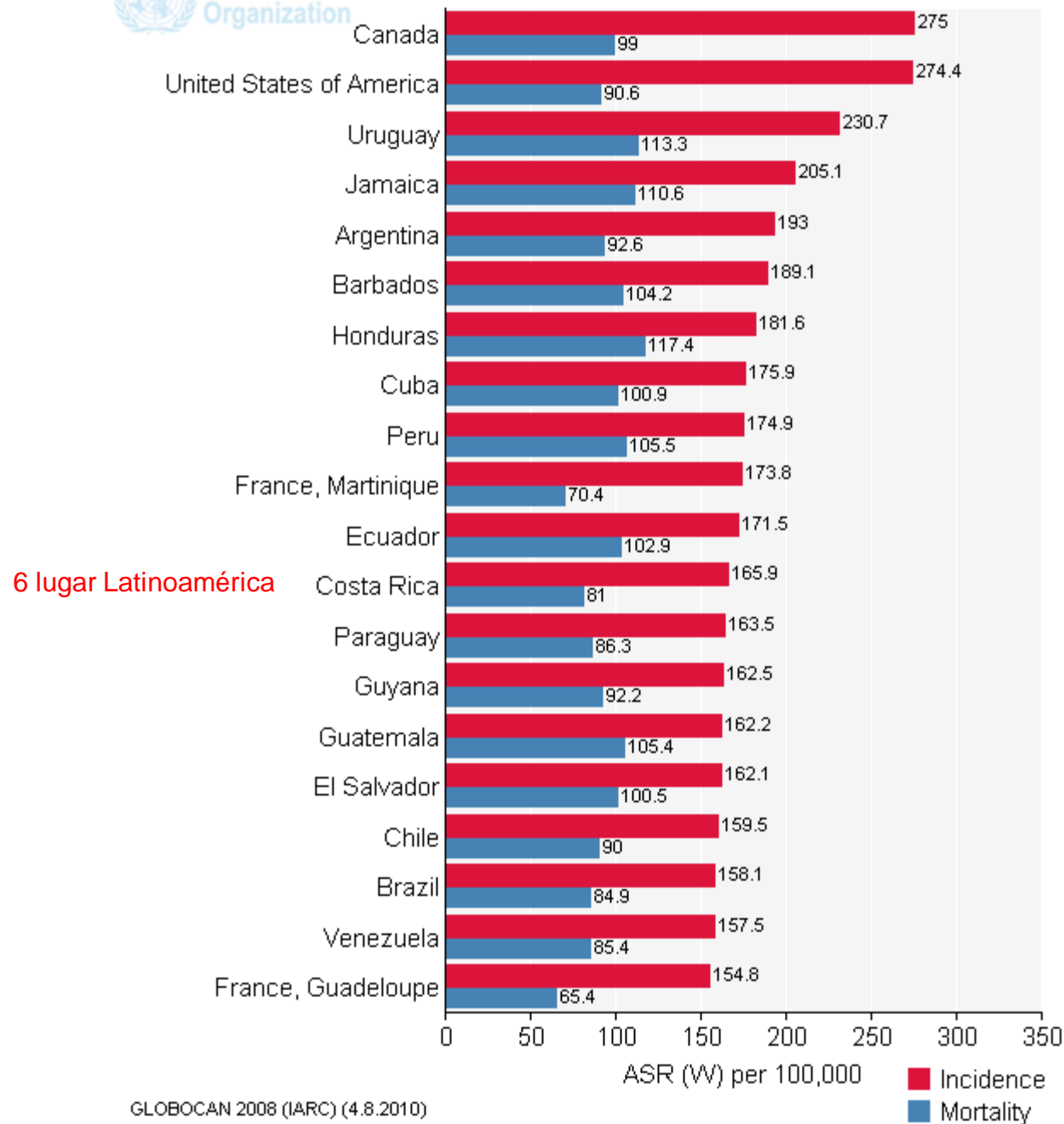

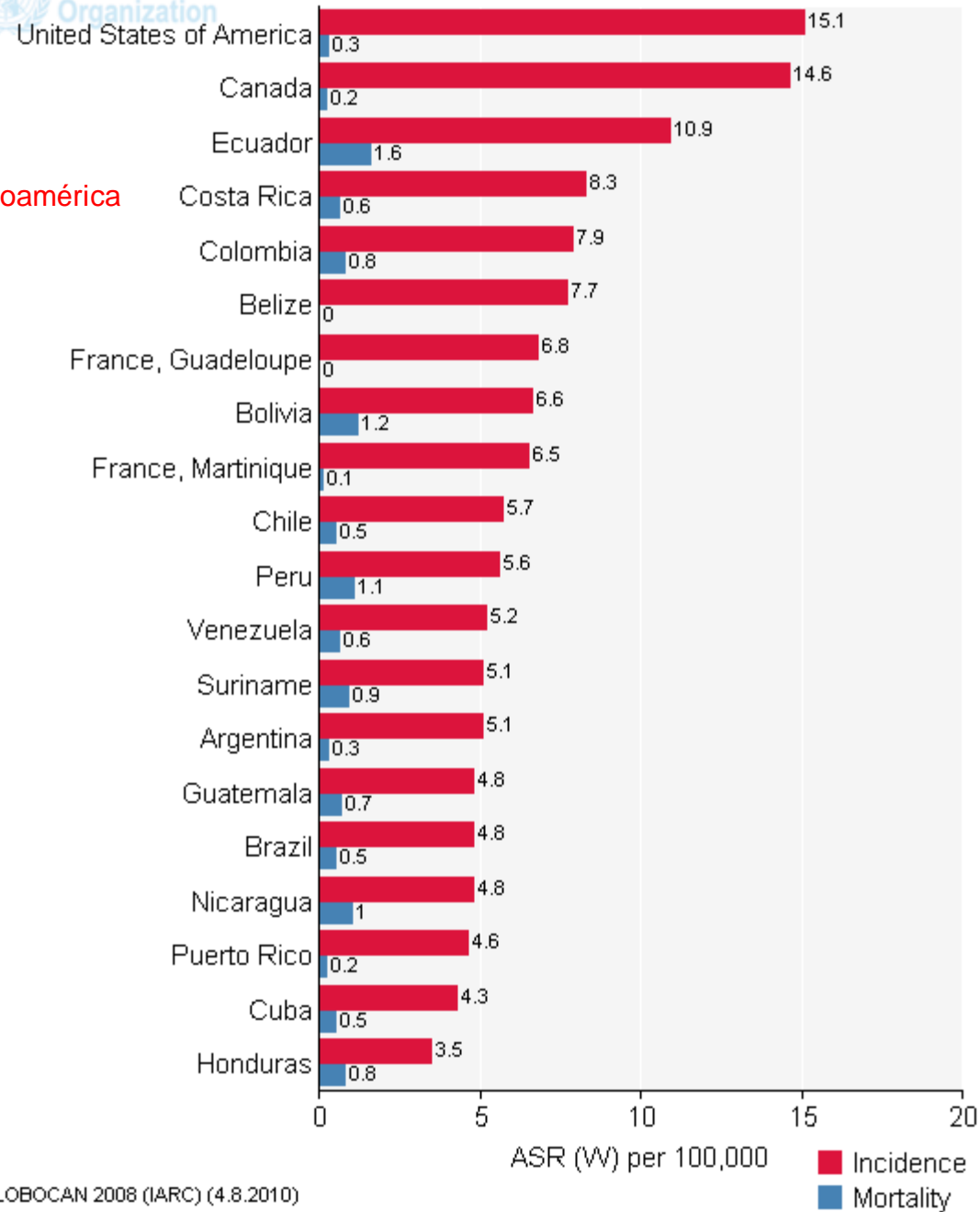

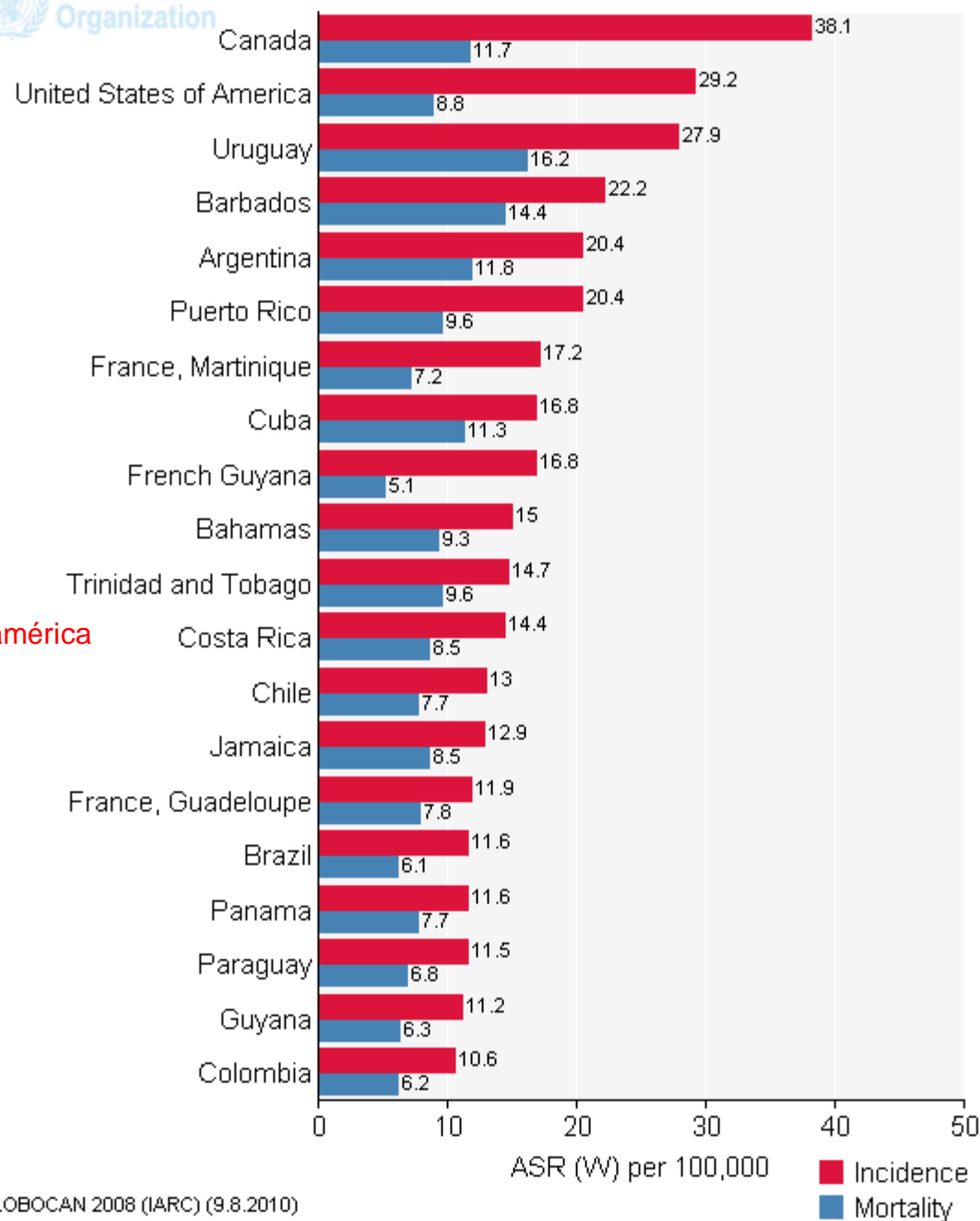

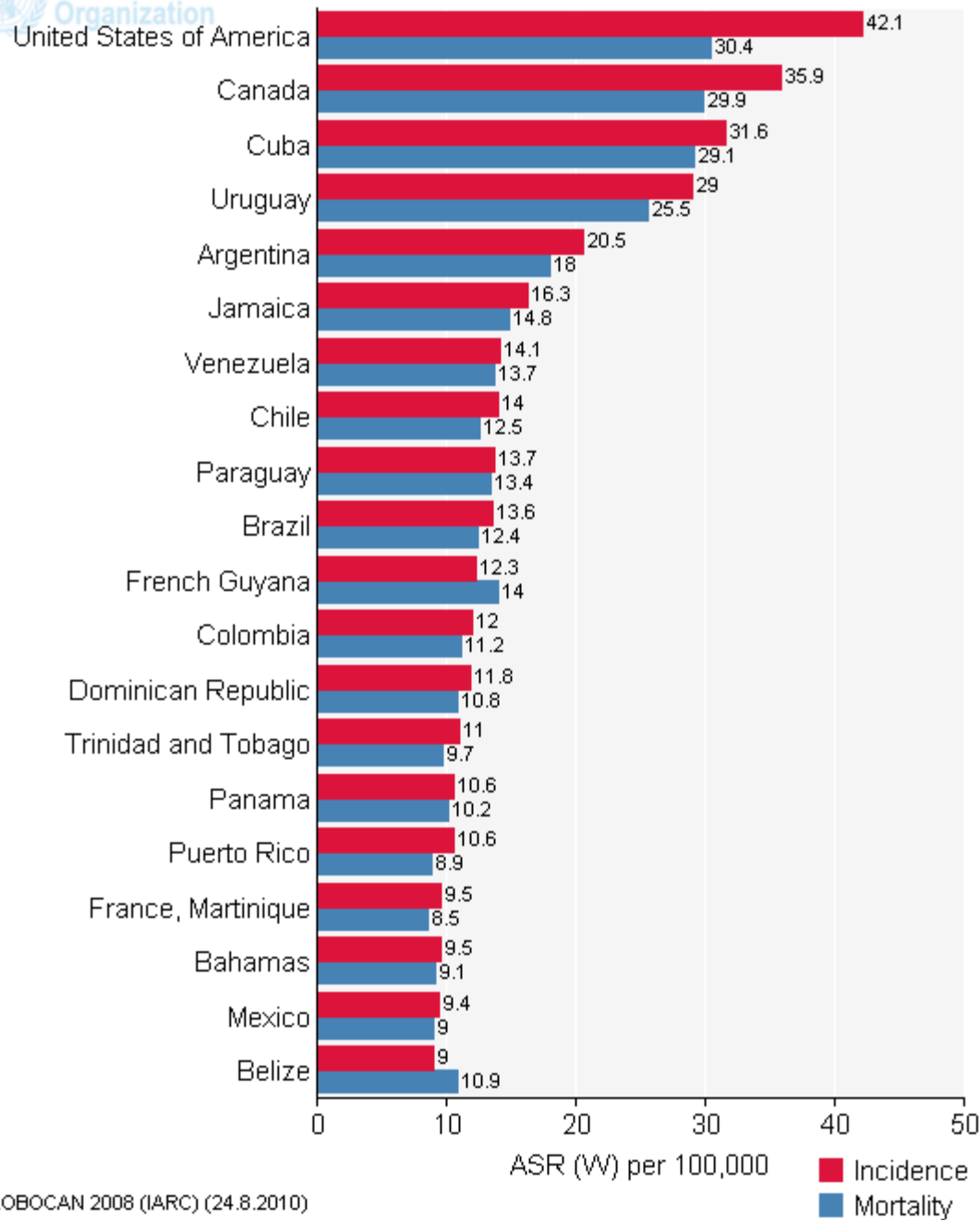

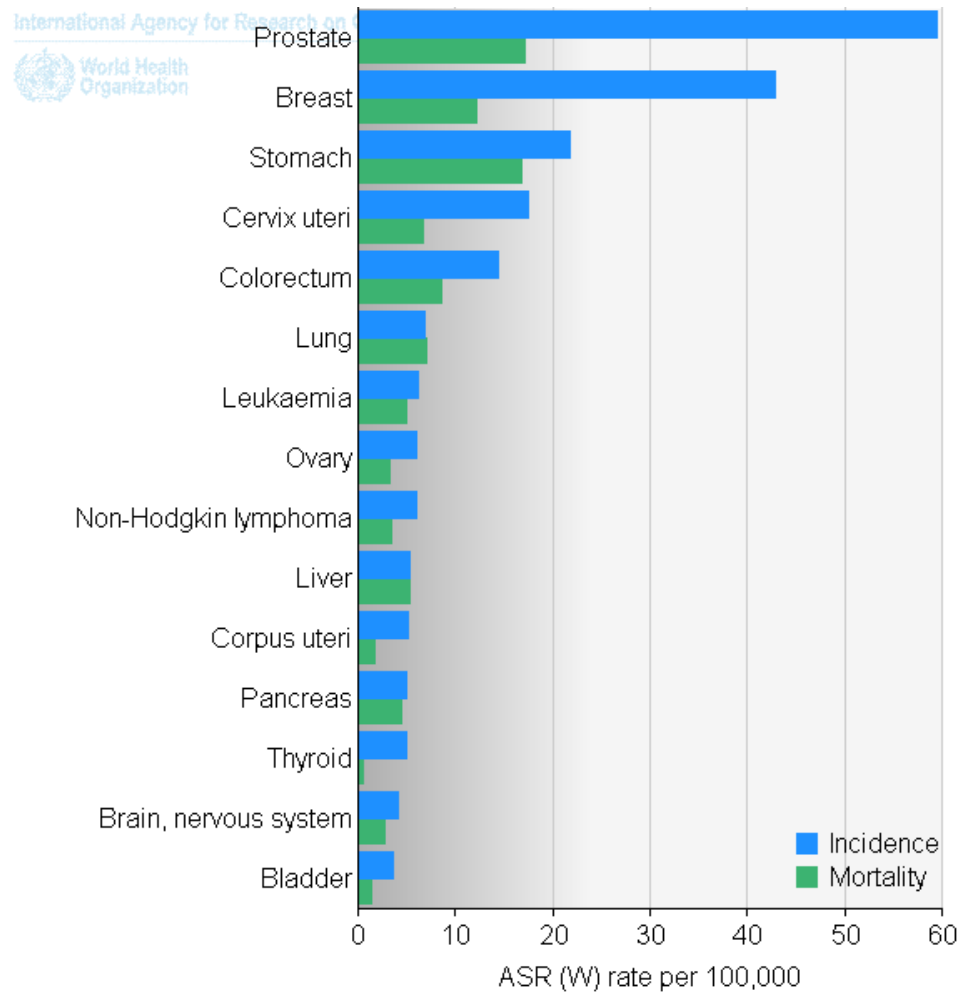




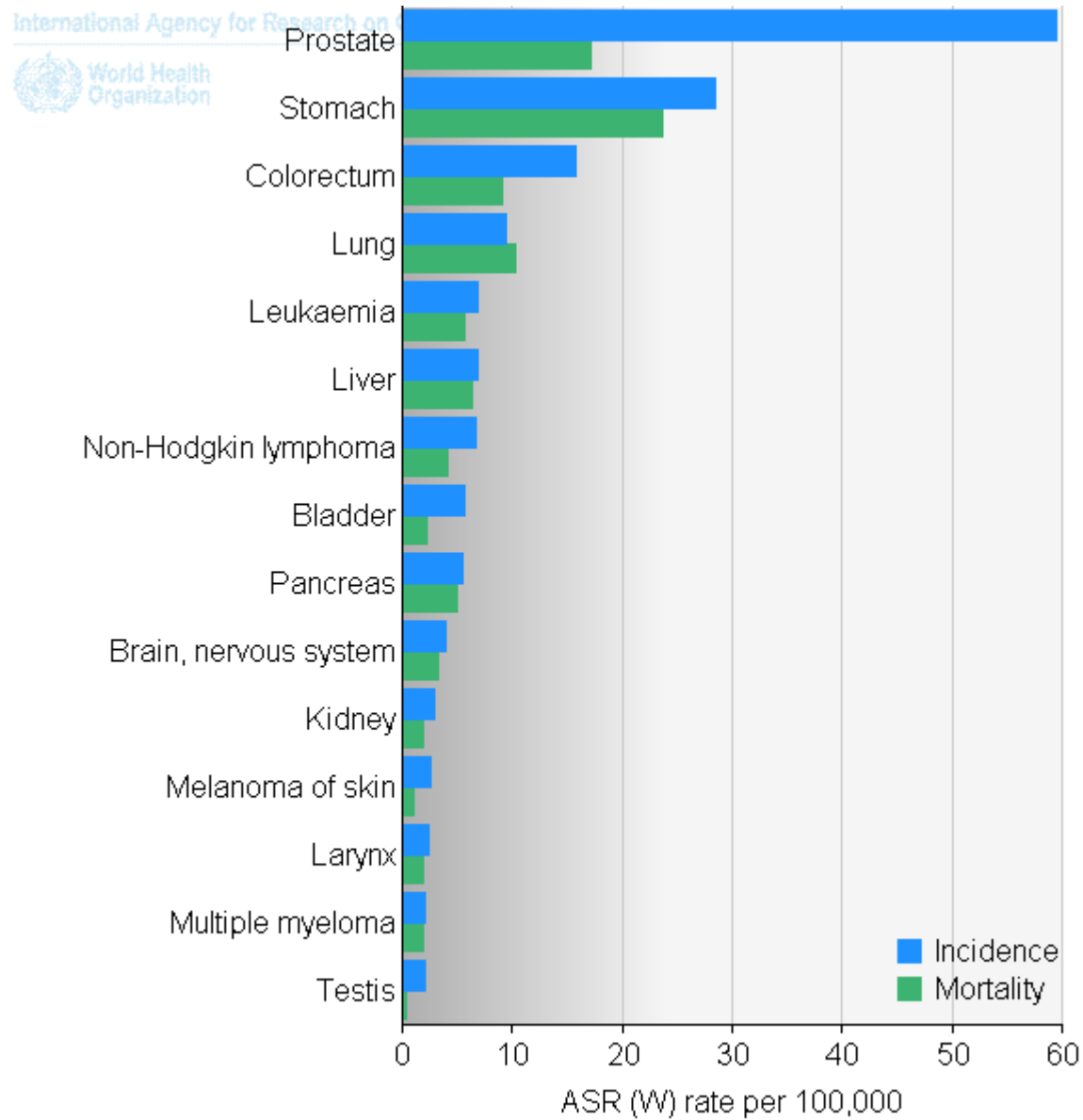
Cumulative risk, age [0-74]



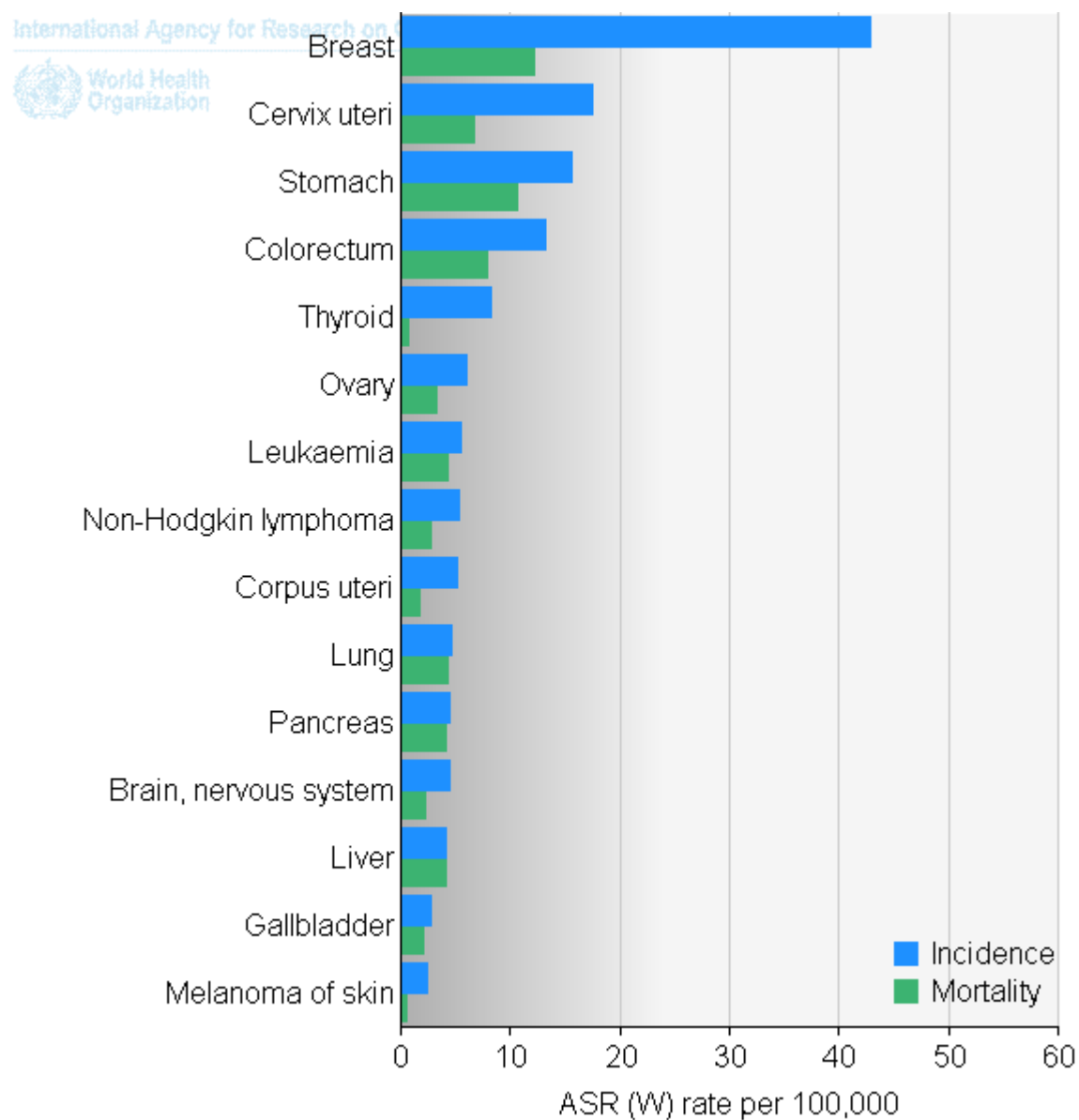
Most frequent cancers: both sexes

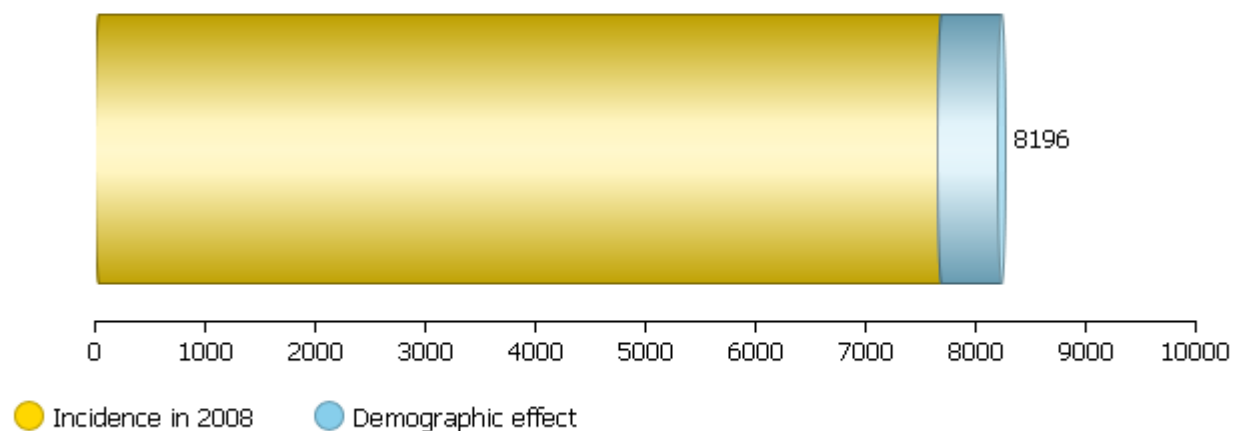

Number of new cancers in 2010 (all ages) - Both sexes



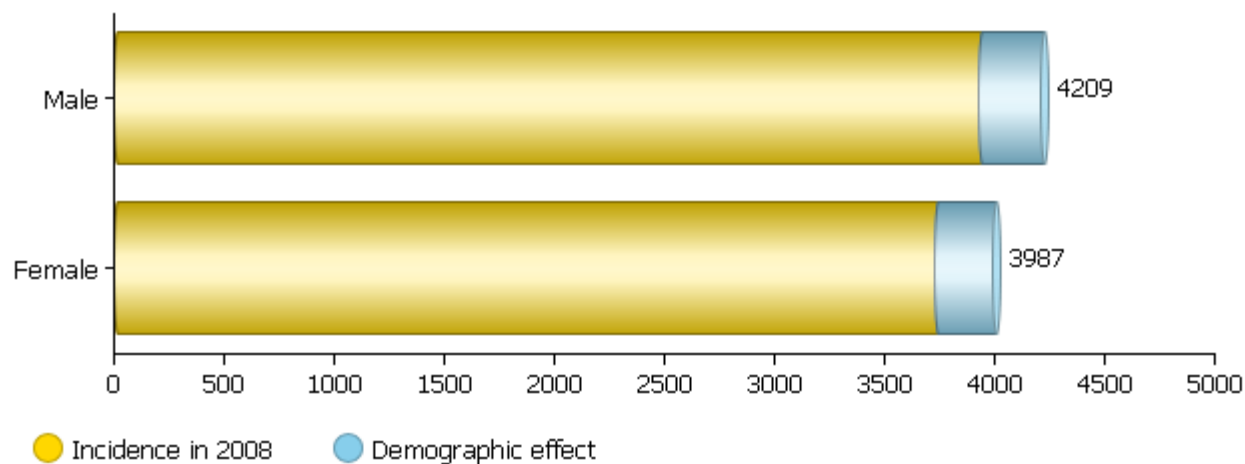

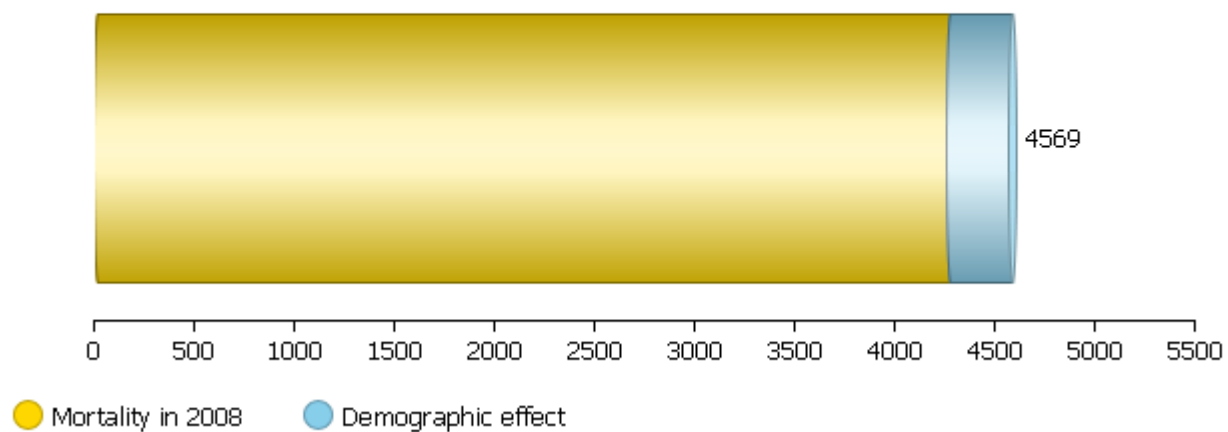

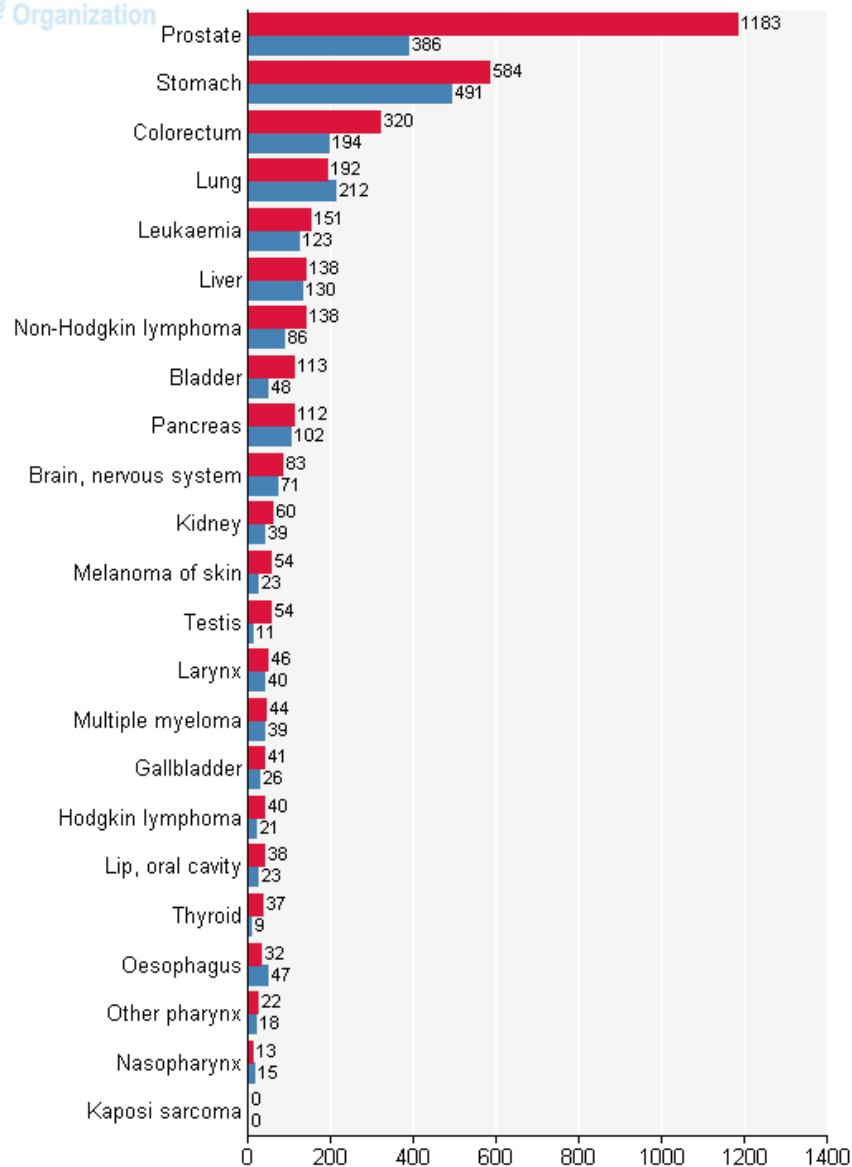

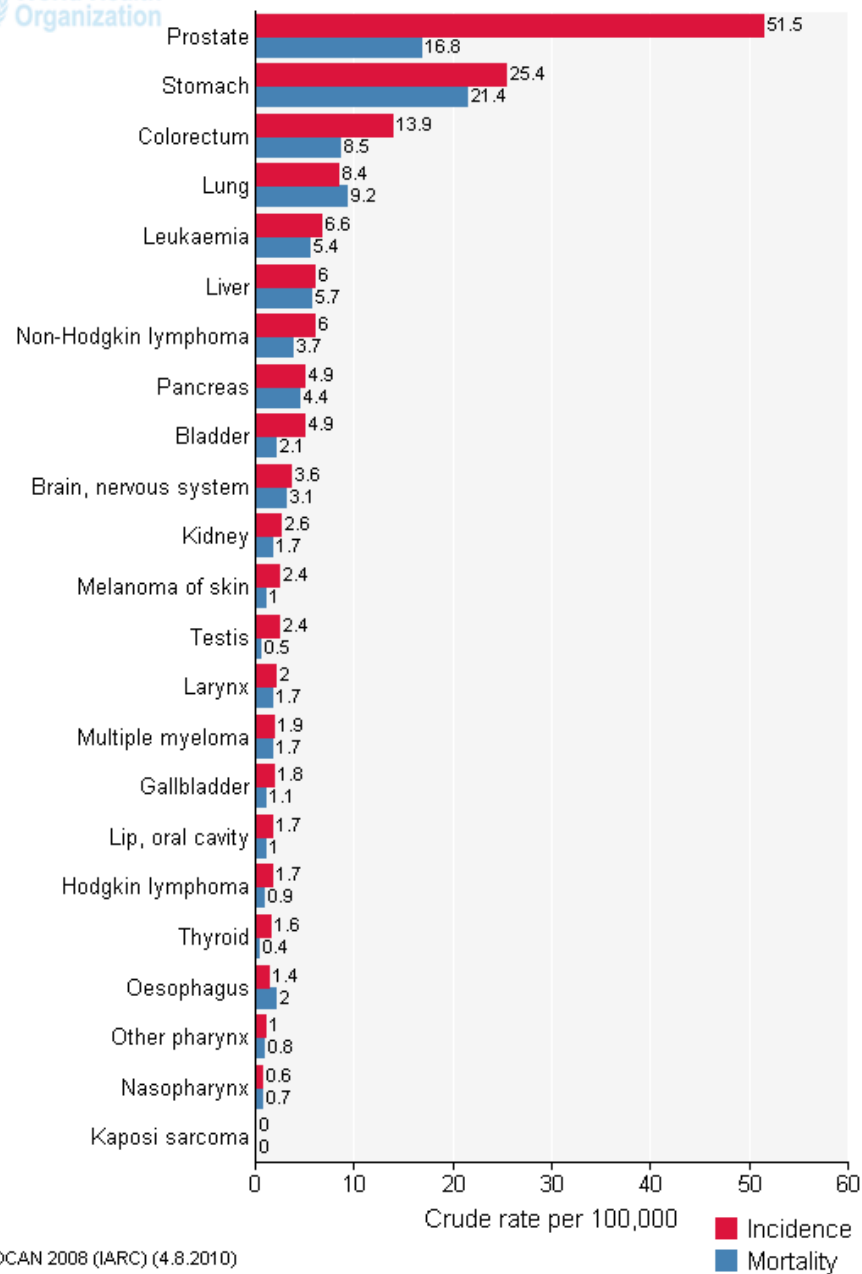

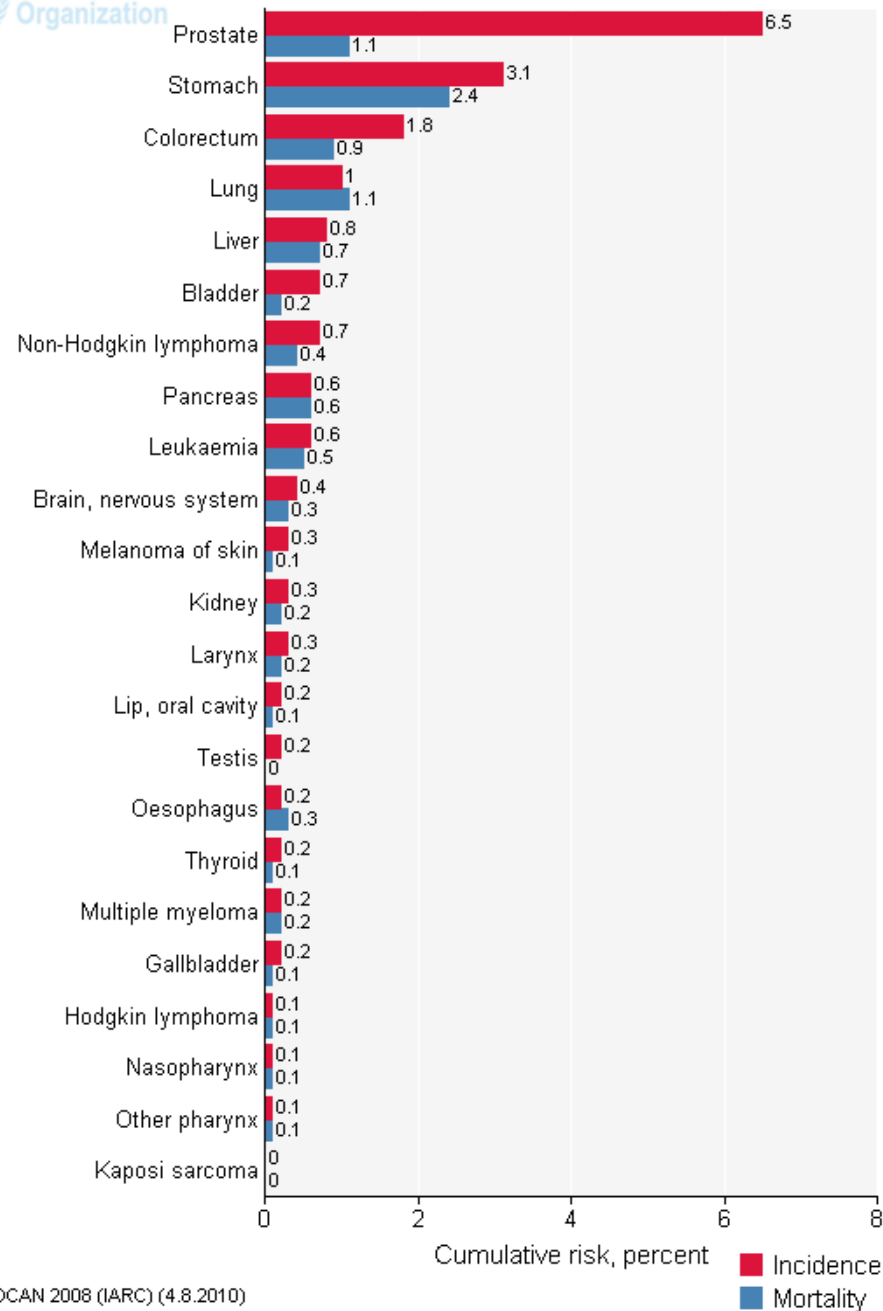
